**Parent Statement**

I give my permission for my child to take part in all school activities, including sports and school-sponsored trips away from the school premises, and absolve the school from liability to me or my child at school or during any school activity.

I understand that the school reserves the right to expel any child who fails to comply with the established regulations and discipline or whose financial obligation remains unpaid after the due date.

I agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of the school by providing a place at home for my child to study and to give my child encouragement in the completion of homework and assignments.

I understand that the standards of Aliso Viejo Christian School do not tolerate dishonoring of the Holy Trinity and the Word of God, profanity, obscenity in word or action, disrespect to the personnel of the school or continued disobedience to the established policies of the school.

I agree to authorize the school to employ such discipline as it deems wise, necessary and within reason of the action committed.

Should legal action, for any reason, be taken against Aliso Viejo Christian School or any employee or agent thereof, on my child's behalf and the school or its agent not be found at fault, I agree to pay any attorney fees, court fees, damages or other costs that Aliso Viejo Christian School or its agent should incur to defend itself against such action.

**Statement of Faith**

This is the statement of faith of our school. Hopefully, it is also the statement of your family's basic Christian conviction. We respect your right to disagree with us. However, your signature below openly grants the school permission to teach your child these Biblical principles as truth. I understand and will support Aliso Viejo Christian School's goal for leading my child into a continuing commitment to Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

**The Bible:** We believe that the Bible is God's Living Word, without error in terms of God's intent in original manuscripts. Inspired by God's Spirit, the Bible is our only final authority in matters of faith and life. (*II Tim. 3:16, Psa. 119:105*)

**God:** We believe that there is one God (Deut. 6:4), eternally existing in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. (*Matt. 3:16-17, 28:29, II Cor. 13:14*)

**Jesus Christ:** We believe that Jesus Christ, in His earthly ministry, was both fully God and fully human, and is equal and co-eternal in the one Triune Godhead. Jesus' death and resurrection paid the penalty for our sins and, by grace through faith, offers believers full forgiveness and eternal salvation. (*I Tim. 3:16, Isaiah 9:6, Rom. 4:25, Col 1:15-20, Gal 2:20, I Peter 2:24*)

**The Holy Spirit:** We believe that the Holy Spirit, also co-eternal in the Triune Godhead, brings us to a saving faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, as the Holy Spirit teaches, gathers, and equips believers to live lives that bring honor and glory to the Lord and fullness of life to the world. (*Acts 2, I Cor. 12:1-31, 14:1-12, Gal. 5*)

**Human Nature:** We believe that human nature contains selfishness and sin, which are not removable by human means. (*Isa. 53, Rom. 3*)

**Salvation:** We believe that Christ alone (*Acts 4:12, John 14:6*) provides what the human condition needs – forgiveness of sins, assurance of eternal life, and joyful peace. This is called salvation and is a free gift (*Grace, Eph. 2:8-9*). We believe that anyone who believes in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior can be certain of this salvation (assurance, *John 5:24*). We believe that we partake of this free gift of grace by faith alone (*Rom. 3:28, John 3:16*), and thereby enter a life-long process of change and growth (sanctification). (*Rom. 12:2, II Cor. 5:17*)

**The Church:** We believe that we are a part of the one, true Church (*Eph. 3:4-6, Rom. 12:5*) made up of all who believe in Christ as Lord and Savior. We extend the proclamation and invitation of this Gospel (salvation through Christ) to all people, and welcome into Christian fellowship all who accept this message and believe in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. (*Rom. 15:7*)

**Prayer:** We believe that God invites us to pray and that He always hears and answers prayers in ways that respect our bidding and fulfill His ultimate will. (*James 5:16, Matt. 18:18-20*)

**Baptism and the Lord's Supper:** We believe that Jesus instituted Holy baptism and the Lord's Supper as a promised means of His grace. We believe the Lord truly acts in the sacraments, and that our faith is an essential part of the equation, which makes the sacraments real and effective. (*Mk. 16:16, I Cor. 11:23-29*)

**The Second Coming of Jesus Christ:** We believe that Jesus Christ will return in glory and power to judge the living and the dead. (*Matt. 25:31, John 14:1-6, Rev. 19-21*)

**Christian Lifestyle – based on the Bible, God's Word given to His Church:** We believe that Christians are to be actively involved in sharing the saving Gospel of Jesus Christ with all people who do not yet believe in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior as the sole means of salvation.

We believe that a full sexual relationship belongs within the boundaries of a publicly committed marriage between one man and one woman.

We believe in the sanctity and defense of all human life including the unborn.

We believe that Christians are to be pro-active in peacemaking, seeking justice, and meeting human needs for all people.

We believe that Christians are to work actively to break down the barriers that divide people – especially those barriers of race, economics, and gender. We do not believe that these distinctions will matter in heaven and teach that the Church on earth should begin to mirror this eventual reality.
