Shaped to Serve? By Pastor Leland Lantz

*O LORD, You are our Father; we are the clay, You are the potter;
we are the work of Your hand. Isaiah 64:8*

The Bible says that God is the potter and I am the clay and I picture myself as a lump of dry clay. The potter gently picks me up with his warm, strong hands. He adds drops of water, to make me flexible and easier to work with. Then, after I am of the correct texture, the potter lifts me higher... higher... and then PLOP!

He throws me down hard to remove all of my air bubbles and flaws. Next he puts me on the wheel and I turn and turn. He shapes me exactly as he wants me, pushing and molding me. Sometimes the pushing hurts, but I know that when he is finished, I will be a beautiful creation. All of this pain, this turning in circles, will be worth it!

As the potter pulls and stretches, I start to take on the shape he wants me to be. And when the potter has me as he wants me, he places me in the kiln to be fired... "It's hot in here!" Now my time in the kiln is done. "Hurry potter, take me out of here! But no, He knows that if I cool too fast I'll crack. He knows what he is doing!

Now it's time... the potter reaches into the kiln and gently lifts me out. I'm solid, strong and stable. My walls are perfect and I have no flaws. The potter uses a glaze to make me beautiful both inside and out. Back into the kiln again!

All that I have been through - being thrown onto the table, the monotony of going round and round on the wheel, the force of his hands, the heat in the kiln - I am wonderfully made by the imprint of God's hands on my life. Are you allowing the Lord to shape your life? He has shaped us to serve Him. We are all special and useful in the Lord's eyes. I hope you are finding ways to use your special gifts and talents to serve the Lord at LCC. I encourage you to use whatever God has given you to serve the Lord... your time, talents and treasures are all important to God.

*October is a time of making commitments to serve the Lord. I hope you are ready to serve because of how God has equipped you with special gifts and talents. The school year always brings a litany of tasks, events and scheduling difficulties. Shifting from a summer schedule to a school schedule is quite shocking no matter how many times you have done it. Getting last minute school supplies, jolting your kids out of bed hours before their summer wake time and getting acclimated to whatever grade level your child is now in.

Just as you feel overwhelmed, so does your child. Whether they acknowledge it or not the myriad of dynamics and challenges they will face socially, academically, athletically, etc. are running through their minds. There are so many things for teens to be worried about these days, many of which probably don't need to be worried about at all, but that is the reality of our culture.

So, what does this mean in regards to your child's spiritual life? In the midst of the expectations, schedules and requirements what does it look like for your child to cultivate a relationship with Jesus? I am sure we would all agree that who our children are is much more important than what they do. Perhaps put another way, I am sure we believe their relationship with God and who they are in Christ is more important than academic achievement, athletic accolades or social conquest. However, how can we practically model and encourage this? What does it mean to parent with the goal being our child's relationship with God and resulting

character? What resources are available in accomplishing this goal?

Of course, the punch line is probably obvious by now, but might I suggest that this is the value of youth group in a teen's life. I realize I am the youth pastor so I am supposed to argue for the importance of youth group, but truly it is important. It is important because it gives your child a place to hear God's Word and wrestle with who God is. It is important because it is a community in which they can be supported by peers who are living Jesus' way of life rather than the world's way of life. It is important because it gives them a place of safety in which other trusted adults can mentor them into a deeper walk with Jesus. It is important because it provides weekly space for them to worship and talk to God. Quite simply, it is important because amidst all the busyness, stress, expectation and pressure of the teen years they need Jesus, and He is the purpose of our ministry.

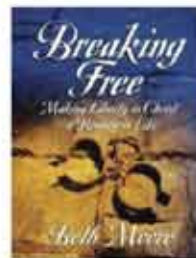
