May the love, grace, forgiveness, and hope of Jesus Christ be poured into each of our lives during this Advent and Christmas season! As we have just given thanks to our Lord for the many blessings in our lives during this Thanksgiving season, let it not stop there. Let us give thanks every day! *Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayers and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.* Philippians 4:4-7

Thank you for your commitments and partnership through the ministries of our church. Many of you have turned in your Time and Talents survey and your Pledge which was mailed to you. Please call or email if you have any further questions. May the Lord richly bless our Christmas season at LCC/AV!

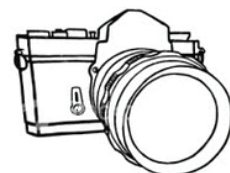

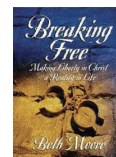
